



Who's In Charge

The planning is done; you have chosen your reception facilities, your caterer, your photographer, your videographer and your DJ or band. It's time for you to relax on your wedding day and turn the details over to – whom?

If you have a wedding coordinator, you will have discussed all of the wedding day details with him/her. You can sometimes hire a wedding day coordinator who will make the arrangements for you; who stands where in the receiving line, when does the music start, when is the cake cut, etc.

Inform the other professionals whom you've appointed, before the day of the wedding. Everything will run harmoniously and you will be free to enjoy your own wedding day.
